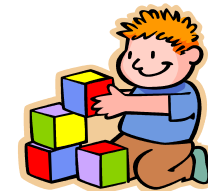

# WHAT IS THE ASQ AND ASQ:SE?

---

The ASQ and ASQ:SE are a series of questionnaires designed to monitor a child's intellectual and emotional development from Birth to 5 years of age.

The **Ages and Stages Questionnaire** looks at children's development in five key areas:

Communication Skills  
Gross Motor Skills  
Fine Motor Skills  
Problem-Solving Skills  
Personal-Social Skills

The **Ages and Stages Social-Emotional Questionnaire** focuses exclusively on the emotional and social development of your child. This refers to your child's ability to interact with others and adapt to new and varying situations.



# WHEN TO DO THE ASQ:

---

There are a total of 19 ASQs and 8 ASQ:SEs. You **DO NOT** need to go through all of them with your child. It is recommended that you do 1 or 2 questionnaires per year until they reach the age of five. You may choose to do more if developmental delays are identified.

# HOW AND WHERE TO DO THE ASQ:

---

The ASQ is a series of activities that you **DO** with your child, that then allow you to answer the questions.

The ASQ is designed to be completed where you and your child are most **COMFORTABLE**. You can do it at home or the Parent Link Center.

# WHO DOES THE ASQ?

---

**YOU Do!** Parents are experts about their children, no one can do the ASQ with your kids as well as **YOU!**

# THE PARENT LINK ASQ PROCESS:

---

1. Complete the ASQ with your child either at a program or at home.
2. Return the ASQ to your Parent Link-coordinator or parent educator.
3. Parent Educator will tally up the questionnaire.
4. Either meet with the Parent Educator during the program or they will set a meeting time with you.
5. Learn new ways to promote intellectual and emotional development in your child. If there are any developmental concerns the Parent Educator will let you know how to get more help.
6. Parent Educator will contact you again in 6 months or a year (depending on what you decided in your first meeting) to begin the ASQ process again.

## DID YOU KNOW?

Children can develop a developmental delay at **ANY** stage in their development.
